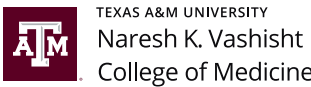


Vision

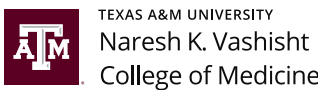
